Rebecca Gottesman-Exhibitions-

She was very impressed with the jurying for the Grafton show. Gary was very good. He picked 38 submissions. He did a slideshow presentation. There were 94 submissions by 41 artists. Ted Nutall will work with Rob. We need feedback from Ted on why he chose those he did as winners. Rebecca is to confirm this with Rob that he will be there at the opening.

Awards will be cash only . Jan wanted Holbein to take one but they can't this year. There is \$1000.00 available this year.

Chandler show for this Fall. - There are 2 jurors provided by the Chandler. The opening will be on Sept 29th and it runs for 5 weeks. This is not an awards show.

We will not be doing an open show but the hubs can do them in their areas.

The Chaffee will do a closed one in July of 2012 to replace Grafton. Rebecca also sent a letter to Visions of VT in Jeffersonville to request a show from them. The Bryant is another possibility. Rebecca needs to send notification for submissions for the Chandler show. JoAnn will talk to Betsy from the Chandler and need to know to whom to send the jpg. The announcement is to be sent to all members by 6/25.

Rebecca will notify Peter Jeziorski about not having the Grafton show next year. We will send him a formal thank you but no gift.

Diane Bell- Publicity-

Kathy Bergeron will do publicity for the state wide coverage. Diane will announce in Snippets that that we need images for the new brochure.
